### Core Objectives:

#### Objective 1

To facilitate the measurement of behavioral and psychosocial factors relevant to HIV/AIDS research;

#### Objective 3

To provide consultation on the conduct of cost-effectiveness analytic methods suitable for assessing the efficiency of a variety of HIV prevention interventions;
